TREMOLO

In music, this technique is the quick repetition of one or two tones. The note is struck as rapidly and continuously as possible. To develop the technique, you must practice slowly and aim for an even sound. Always seek for a clear articulation of the notes. Remember! We're looking for the perfect sound at first. Speed will take time!
